Kathryn Lynch will be included "Ferragosto" our summer group show from July 12th to August 17th. New works by Kathryn Lynch will be exhibited in her inaugural solo exhibition with Sears Peyton Gallery, April 17-May 17, 2008. Paintings and works on paper are also available for viewing at our Chelsea gallery.

What we first notice about Kathryn Lynch's paintings are the subtle contrasts between light and dark that permeate the interior of the painting. Her ability to capture in an instant the mysterious disposition of her daily view is a style that is not concerned with the minute details of the subject matter. The paintings depict a private world filled with sensitivity and reverence. The subject matter is familiar yet our sense of what is going on yields to the abstract. It is in this delicate balance of what is in front of her and how she translates it through paint that makes her pictures captivating and modern.

Kathryn Lynch has shown extensively in New York, Boston, Philadelphia, and Portland. She has been an artist in residence at Yaddo and the Skowhegan School of Painting and Sculpture and is the recipient of a Marie Walsh Sharpe Foundation grant. Her work is in numerous private and public collections including the University of California at Berkeley Museum.
