DAUM MUSEUM OF CONTEMPORARY ART ACQUIRES PAINTING BY MARYBETH THIELHELM

Sears-Peyton Gallery is proud to announce that the Daum Museum of Contemporary Art in Sedalia, Missouri, has acquired a painting by New York artist MaryBeth Thielhelm. The Daum Museum is located at the midpoint of Missouri's two major cultural centers, Kansas City and St. Louis. The core of the museum is the permanent collection which is comprised of abstract paintings, drawings, prints and sculpture created since the mid 20th century. The collection includes works by Jules Olitski, Larry Poons, Jim Dine, Alex Katz, Ellsworth Kelley, Sol LeWitt and Robert Longo.

MaryBeth Thielhelm's oil on panel painting entitled "Gossamer Grey Sea" will be on view this summer in an exhibition entitled "Black and White works from the Permanent Collection" which opens June 10th.

Thielhelm's painting was exhibited in "Nameless Seas", her second solo show with Sears-Peyton Gallery.
